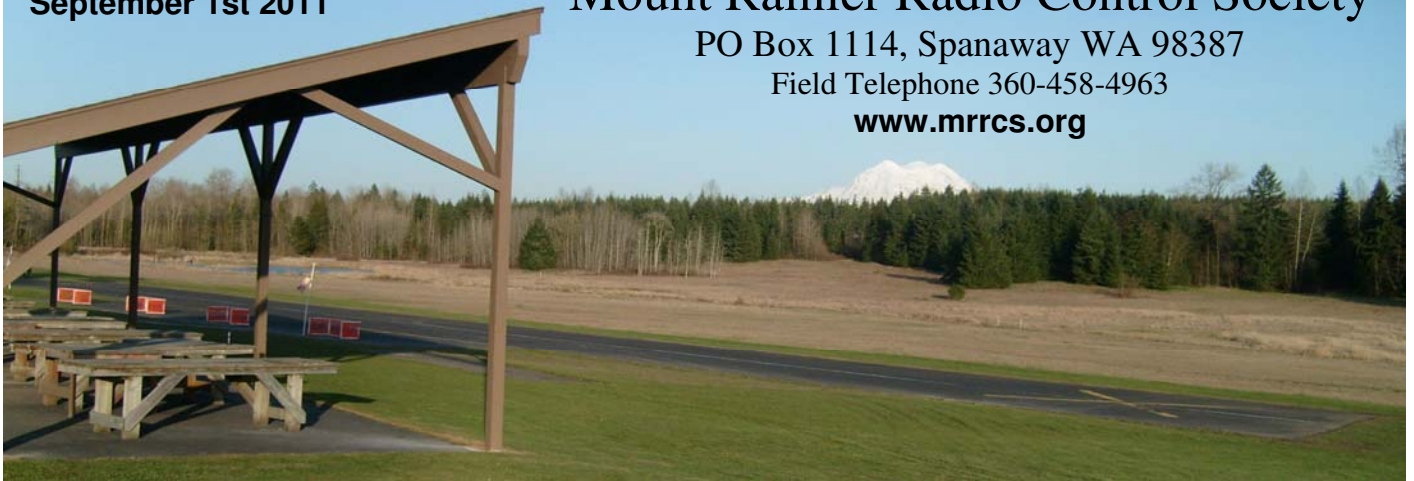

Flight Instruction

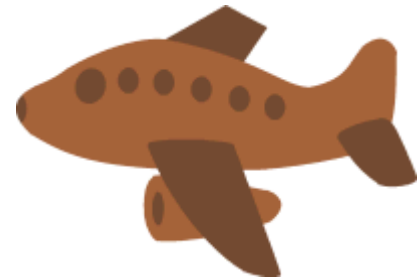
